St Andrews Church, High Ham with Low Ham

The church stands in a commanding position on the edge of the village green at the centre of our parish of High Ham with Low Ham. It is the tallest building in the village, indeed it is the highest point of the whole of the new benefice or group of churches which comprise High Ham with Low Ham, North Episcopi with Longpost, Aller, Cury Rival, Drayton, Swell and Fivehead.

We are currently being looked after by the Rev Scott Paterson who has an impossible task of ministering to 7 parishes in a part-time role until a new vicar is appointed. The closing date for applicants is only 10 days away so we hope to have news of an appointment soon but it may be towards Christmas that we actually have a new vicar in post.

The church holds regular services as advertised on the village website. There is a Holy Communion service on the 1st Sunday, a team service which we alternate with Aisk on the second Sunday, a family service on the 3rd Sunday and an afternoon service on the 4th Sunday.
